#### Stall Rates:

Food Stall	\$990.00 per stall & \$1500.00 per double stall, inc. GST + Council Fee.
General Stall (non-food)	\$660.00 per stall inc. GST.
Corporate Stall	\$2000.00 inc. GST.

**Corporate stall will be a 4m x 4m covered marquee with 3 tables and 6 chairs**

**Food and General Stall will be the standard Fete stall with dimensions of 2.4m x 2.4m with one chair**

**Food Stalls will have food preparation area behind the stall and electricity point**



**CONDITIONS AND GUIDELINES FOR FOOD AND OTHER STALLS**

1. All money paid is refundable if the stall is not approved. However, 50% of the amount would be deductible if booking is cancelled after 30 Sept 2011.
2. **ALL** Stall holder must have current **Third Party / Public Liability Insurance** and copy of the current Certificate of Currency must be provided with the application. The first page of current insurance document with Name, Number and date should be sent with application.
3. **Alcoholic beverages** and **water bottles** are not allowed to be served or sold. **Masala Tea, Lassi** can be sold.
4. Only **VEGETARIAN FOOD** is allowed to be sold at the fair.
5. Food stall holders must obtain a **Food license** from Parramatta Council and Hindu council can provide more information.
6. Food Stall holder must notify Food Notify authority for their operations at Deepavali fair. **Please visit [www.foodnotify.nsw.gov.au](http://www.foodnotify.nsw.gov.au)** about requirements.
7. **Stall holders** are required to set up their stall before 9.00 am on 30 Oct and start trading from 12 noon on 30 Oct 2011 and must finish trading 9:00 pm and must vacate the premises by 11.00 pm. All vehicles must be removed from loading / unloading area by 12.00 midnight. Access to stadium will be available on 29 Oct from 12.00 noon. The security staff can ask to remove any vehicle seen at other times.
8. Unless approved by HCA, selling of food other than the approved stalls, collection of any money and distribution of any pamphlets is strictly prohibited.
9. Food items on sale must be hygienically handled and prepared in accordance with the health and food standards of the state of New South Wales.
10. The stallholder takes full responsibility of operating the stall. The stallholder indemnifies Hindu Council of Australia and the Parramatta Stadium against all claims and demands of any kind and from any liability which may arise due to any actions, products or any services provided to public, any accident, damage, death or injury to any third person and/or staff member or property at and/or around the stall.
11. It is advised to bring your own trolley to carry your goods to the stall to avoid any congestion and delays.
12. All vehicles used at the venue must be driven at a walking pace with hazard lights on.
13. Promotional banners and signage can only be exhibited with prior written approval from HCA.
14. All rubbish must be kept in the bins provided by stall holder. The stall area must be left clean. A clearance note in writing must be obtained from HCA before leaving the grounds. Any rubbish left by the stallholder at the site will incur cleanup cost.
15. Do not remove, replace, refit or re-locate the stall or its contents, any issues or problems must be informed to the HCA.
16. Each Stall holder will be notified upon approval with location map.
17. To abide by any other conditions, which may be issued by HCA for safety and smooth operation of the stalls.
18. Stallholder found in violation of the above conditions, agrees to vacate the premises immediately. Stall rent will not be refundable.
19. HCA reserves the right to cancel any stall operation. All stall booking fees/ costs are non- refundable.
